After surviving a factory building collapse, a former child worker is arrested while campaigning for safer working conditions in the fashion industry.

For ten years, a man sleeps in a tent in Parliament Square to protest against war and foreign policy. He only leaves his campsite to attend court hearings, surviving on food brought to him by supporters.

The company will use movement, storytelling, and a wide variety of devising methods to create their own piece, telling the stories of those who decided that it was time to act now.
